5 FAQ's about Fiber to the Home

1) What are the fastest speeds available and how much will they cost per month?

1 GB - \$149.95	50 Mbps - \$99.95
100 Mbps – \$129.95	25 Mbps - \$89.95

2) What speed do I really need? This is based on how many devices are connected and what those devices are being used for. For example, to stream 4K content a speed of 25 Mbps or higher is recommended.

3) Is it really unlimited? YES! We do not cap your internet usage.

4) Are there special promotions now that you are offering faster speeds? Anyone who increases their current internet speed to 15 Mbps or higher will receive 2 months free and a free Google Chromecast Ultra!

5) Does somebody have to come to my house? Yes. These newer speeds are only possible with updated equipment. Our technicians are generally onsite for about 1 hour. Additionally, for those upgrading to a premium speed, our techs can provide you with a heat map that will tell you the ideal location for your wireless router. This will help determine the best location for your wi-fi signal and should help eliminate areas with low connectivity.

Galaxy S8 Review

My name is Jared Chase, I am the Customer Service Supervisor at Copper Valley Telecom, and I use the Samsung Galaxy S8+. Like many, I do my research before committing to a device. I want a phone that is fast, slim, and takes good pictures. This phone meets all three of those three criteria.

Fast: 4GB of RAM! What does that mean? It means that the phone can handle jumping back and forth between apps. It means that I can run heavy duty apps like HD games & Photoshop. It means my phone is ready for whatever app I need to download in the future.

Slim: This phone fits in my pocket! Not only that, because it is so slim my thumb and fingers can reach the entire screen without having to use two hands.

Takes Good Pictures: 12-megapixels with an f/1.7. What does that mean? It means the photos are large and the camera will perform well even in low light. However, when it comes to digital images it's not all about megapixels anymore. It's about the complicated processing behind the sensor. Cameras are my specialty. I could go on and on about the sensor's focal points, the autofocus system, and the HDR capabilities. Essentially, at this time, there is no better camera on any of our phones at Copper Valley Telecom.

I have been using this phone for two months now with no issues and no regrets. For those of you who are familiar with Android devices, this is the phone I would recommend. If you are looking for an Apple product, the only thing that compares is the iPhone 7.
