



Notice of Temporary Apprenticeship Opportunity – Summer 2017

Copper Valley Telecom, in cooperation with the NECA/IBEW Apprenticeship, is accepting applications for the position of Telecommunications Apprentice. Applications will be accepted along with required documentation at Copper Valley Telecom until June 6, 2017 at 5:00 p.m. Work is anticipated to begin in July and last through the summer.

All applicants that meet the following minimum qualifications are encouraged to apply.

1. Must be at least 18 years of age.
2. Must be a high school graduate or have a GED.
3. Must provide a copy of official (sealed) high school transcripts.
4. Must meet minimum math requirements as follows:
 - completed a minimum of two semesters of high school level algebra or one semester of college level algebra with a passing grade of C or better.
 - scored a 6 or better on the State of Alaska Work Keys Math Assessment.
 - successfully complete the NJATC Online Tech Math Course (www.njatc.utk.edu/)
5. Must have a valid Alaska Driver's License.
6. Must provide a copy of current 5 year driving record.
7. Must submit a \$25.00 processing fee along with application and required documentation.

All applicants will be accepted without regard to race, color, religion, national origin, or sex.

Interviews will be scheduled for all applicants that meet the minimum qualifications.
